



Find Your Ring Size

1. Check that this printed Ring Sizing Chart is to scale by measuring the scale at the bottom of the page. The scale should measure exactly 2 cm. If not, do not proceed. Check printer settings > page scaling and try again.
2. Place your ring over the circles. You'll know it's a perfect match when the inside edge of your ring matches the inside edge of the circle.
3. If your ring is in between two sizes, I recommend ordering the larger size or getting a professional fitting to see which size is best for you.
4. Remember, the thicker the ring band, the tighter the fit. If you choose a ring with a deep band width, you may need to order half a size larger or get a professional fitting.

Remember

1. If you're not sure what ring size you are, it's best to visit your local jewellery store for a professional fitting. That way you can be confident that the ring you order will fit perfectly. If you've spotted the perfect ring and can't wait to place your order, follow the steps above to work out your ring size.
2. Measure your ring size in the evening, on the finger it will be worn on, when your finger is largest. Avoid measuring when you're cold, as your fingers can be smaller than usual.
3. Find a ring that fits you perfectly. It shouldn't slide off too easily, or feel too tight. In between is just right.
